Rongstad scored a career-high 29 points in a 88-86 victory against Winona State Saturday, guiding the Beavers to a season-sweep of the Warriors for the first time since the 2003-04 season. In the game he shot 7-of-12 from the field, 2-of-4 from beyond the arc and 13-of-15 from the free throw line, establishing career-highs in both free throws made and attempted. In the game's final 2:31, Rongstad hit 10-of-12 free throws, had a steal and an offensive rebound off a missed free throw to keep the ball on BSU's end when the score was 87-85 and only four seconds on the clock. In the game he added seven rebounds and two blocks, playing in 37 minutes. BSU went 2-0 on the week as they hosted Finlandia University in a non-conference game, winning by the score of 99-67. For the week, Rongstad averaged 28.5 minutes, 20.5 points, 5.5 rebounds, 1.5 steals and 1.0 blocks per game. He shot 50 percent from the field, 40 percent from beyond the arc and 88.2 percent from the charity stripe. BSU is on a four-game winning streak. During that streak, Rongstad is averaging 20.3 points and 6.0 rebounds, shooting 52.2 percent.

NSIC/Sanford Health Men's Basketball Tournament



AUGUSTANA COLLEGE - Augustana suffered its worst 3-point shooting performance and also one of its best as the 19th-ranked Vikings split a pair of road games last week. In Friday's 71-59 loss to U-Mary, the Vikings made just 1 of 21 (4.8 percent) shots beyond the arc. However, Augustana bounced back strong 24 hours later in its 88-72 win over Northern State. The Vikings connected on 11 of 17 3-point shots (64.7 percent), which was their second-best percentage of the season. Cameron McCaffrey made 5 of 6 treys, while Nathan Truex made 4 of 5 shots. With Saturday's win along with Winona State's loss, the Vikings secured a first-round home game for the conference tournament as at least the No. 3 seed.

BEMIDJI STATE - #3 Lance Rongstad (Fr., G/F, 6-3, 200, Eleva, Wis., Eleva-Stum HS) scored a career-high 29 points in a 88-86 victory against Winona State University Saturday, guiding the Beavers to a season-sweep of the Warriors for the first time since the 2003-04 season. In the game he shot 7-of-12 from the field, 2-of-4 from beyond the arc and 13-of-15 from the free throw line, establishing career-highs in both free throws made and attempted. In the game's final 2:31, Rongstad hit 10-of-12 free throws, had a steal and an offensive rebound off a missed free throw to keep the ball on BSU's end when the score was 87-85 and only four seconds on the clock. In the game he added seven rebounds and two blocks, playing in 37 minutes. Both blocks came within the 8:35 and 6:34 marks of the second half. Both were 3-point attempts that would have given the Warriors a lead or cut the deficit to two points. BSU went 2-0 on the week as they hosted Finlandia University in a nonconference game, winning by the score of 99-67. For the week, Rongstad averaged 28.5 minutes, 20.5 points, 5.5 rebounds, 1.5 steals and 1.0 blocks per game. He shot 50 percent from the field, 40 percent from beyond the arc and 88.2 percent from the charity stripe. BSU is on a four-game winning streak. During that streak, Rongstad is averaging 20.3 points and 6.0 rebounds, shooting 52.2 percent.

CONCORDIA-ST. PAUL - Brent Barz (C, So., Johnston, Iowa) came off the bench and shot 80% from the field and the free throw line, hitting eight of 10 at each location for a game-high 24 points while collecting six rebounds in just 20 minutes of action. It was his third 20-point outing of the season and he is now shooting 57.4% from the floor on the year.

Senior forward Craig Heiman (Marshall, Wis.) scored 22 points to move into third on the NSIC Career Scoring List with 1,188 points, surpassing Michigan Tech's Larry Grimes (1968-72) with 1,167. His four rebounds vaulted him into 15th in the league's career rebounding charts with 357, moving ahead of Bemidji State's Charles Hanks (2001-04) and Wayne State's Todd Kolstermann (2000-04) with 354 and 355, respectively. Heiman has achieved the lofty totals in 74 career NSIC games and has averaged over 31 minutes per game since his sophomore season after clocking over 20 minutes per game as a freshman in league games.

UNIVERSITY OF MARY - Jordan Wilhelm (G, 6-5, Jr., Bismarck, ND) paced the Marauders to an upset of #19 Augustana on Friday night. The junior guard nailed all five of his three point attempts and scored a game-high 23 points in the 71-59 U-Mary win. Wilhelm hit 9-of-12 shots from the field and added six rebounds and two assists. Anthony Moody (G, 6-0, Jr., Appleton, WI) snared a career-high nine rebounds and added 15 points, two blocks and four assists in the win. Eric Erdmann (F, 6-5, Jr., Fargo, ND) added 17 points, seven rebounds, made 8-of-11 shots and had two blocks. Erdmann also was stellar offensively the next evening against Wayne State, scoring 19 points to go with two steals and two assists.

MINNESOTA, CROOKSTON - The University of Minnesota, Crookston Men's Basketball team dropped an 86-57 game at St. Cloud State University on Saturday. The Golden Eagles close out the 2009-2010 season with three home games. They will host Finlandia University on Monday, February 22 in non-conference action starting at 7:30 pm. They host the University of Mary in NSIC action on Wednesday, February 24 at 8:00 pm. On Saturday, February 27, Minnesota State University Moorhead comes to town for the season finale. U of M, Crookston is led by Adam Hendricks (Jr, F, Watertown, Minn. – Watertown-Mayer H.S.) who is averaging 10.2 points (106-for-207) per game. Matthew Heier (Sr, G, Ray, N.D. – Williston State College) is averaging 10.0 points (63-for-164) per game.

MINNESOTA DULUTH - A career-high 22 points from freshman Jake Hottenstine and 14-point performances by both sophomore guard Ryan Rasmussen and senior forward Steve Duncan were not enough for the University of Minnesota Duluth to snap out of its recent losing funk. The Bulldogs lost their ninth straight game Saturday afternoon at Romano Gymnasium, falling to Upper Iowa University by a 77-70 margin.

MINNESOTA STATE - Jefferson Mason (G, Jr., Crystal, Minn.) poured in a game-high 16 points in MSU's 81-64 victory over Southwest Minnesota State Saturday. Mason, who finished the game 6-of-9 from the floor, including 2-of-2 from three-point line, finished tied for the team lead with five rebounds. He also stuffed the stat sheet by passing out four assists – which also tied a team-high – while also collecting four steals and one blocked shot. He did it all in 31 minutes of action.

Junior guard Taylor Morrow scored a career-high 15 points in MSU's win at Southwest Minnesota State...MSU has shot 50 percent or better in 13 or more games this season...MSU opened Saturday's night game falling behind 15-4 in rebounds after the first 10 minutes and finished the game outrebounding SMSU 35-30, including 31-15 in the final 30 minutes of the game...The Maverick bench has scored 910 points this year, and average of 36.4 points per game...MSU sits 10th on the single-season points scored list with 2,218...The Mavericks have made 508 free throws this year and attempted 678...Both the FTM and FTA's rank sixth on the single-season list..





MSU MOORHEAD - The Dragons men's basketball team surprised the Concordia St. Paul Golden Bears on Saturday as they upset the home team, 88-82. Driscoll led the Dragons with 20 points in the game. VanHavermaet posted 19 and went 5-10 from three-point range. Williamson hit six field goals and went 6-6 from the charity stripe, totaling 18 points in the game. The Dragons will host Northern State for their final regular season home game on Wednesday at 8 p.m.

NORTHERN STATE - Collin Pryor (F, 6-6, 190, R-Fr., St. Charles, Ill./St. Charles East HS) averaged 14.5 points and 7.0 rebounds per game for the Wolves while shooting 57.9 percent from the field in the Wolves' two losses this weekend. The redshirt freshman notched six points and six rebounds off the bench on Friday, but came back on Saturday to post a career-high 23 points to go along with his eight boards against 19th ranked Augustana. Pryor currently leads the Wolves in field goal percentage and is second in free throw shooting. NSU Legendary MBB Coach Don Meyer announced that he will retire at the end of the season.

SMSU - Senior forward Kevin Andrews (6-4, Marion, Iowa) scored a game-high 21 points on 5 of 8 shooting, including 8 of 8 from the free throw line in SMSU's 81-64 loss to No. 7 MSU.

ST. CLOUD STATE - St. Cloud State brings an eight game winning streak into the final week of the regular season as the Huskies are coming off an 86-57 win over Minnesota, Crookston last Saturday. This is the second longest win streak of the season for the Huskies as SCSU won ten straight from Dec. 5 to Jan. 15. St. Cloud State will finish out the regular season at home on Wed., Feb. 24 against Concordia-St. Paul and on the road at Winona State on Saturday, Feb. 27. The Huskies have posted a 13-1 record at Halenbeck Hall this season. Matt Schneck (Sr., C, Whitefish Bay, Wis.) led the Huskies in scoring and rebounding with 14 points and nine rebounds against UMC. He made eight of eight free throw attempts. Tim Bergstraser (Fr., F, St. Cloud) had a solid game for the Huskies with a career high 14 points and seven rebounds, that included eight of nine free throw shooting. The Huskies are in second place in the NSIC standings, ranked third in the NCAA Division II Central Region poll, and entered the national poll last week at the #20 spot.

UPPER IOWA - Matt Lesan (G, 6-2, Jr., Solon, Iowa) led the Peacocks to a important road win at Minnesota Duluth on Saturday. Lesan led Upper Iowa in scoring with 21 on 6 of 12 shooting including a pair of trifectas. The junior also made 7 of his 10 free throw attempts as the Peacocks defeated the Bulldogs to move into a three way tie for 8th. Upper Iowa will wrap up their Northern Sun Conference season with a road game at Winona State this Wednesday and a home game on Saturday afternoon in Fayette against Concordia University, St. Paul.

WAYNE STATE - Jason Jensen (G, 6-4, Jr., Milwaukee, Wis./Texas-Pan American) averaged 20 points, 6.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game in helping the Wildcats to an impressive NSIC road sweep over the weekend at Northern State and Mary. Jensen had 15 points, six rebounds and three assists in Friday's 73-58 win at Northern State and followed that with a team-high 25 points, making 10 of 16 shots from the field and 5 of 5 from the three point line in a 76-53 rout at Mary, handing the Marauders their first home loss of the season. For the weekend, Jensen made 15 of 26 shots from the field (57.7%), 7 of 9 three point shots (77.8%) and 3 of 5 attempts (60%) at the free throw stripe. With the two wins, Wayne State moved from ninth to seventh in the NSIC standings entering the final week of the conference schedule.

WINONA STATE - Winona State University played only one game this week and lost 88-86 to Bemidji State University in Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference play. Ben Fischer (G, Jr., Wausau, Wis.) had a full statistical game in the loss to BSU, hitting 9-of-14 shots from the field, equaling a career-high three three-point fields out of six attempts, netted 4-of-6 free throw attempts and finished with 25 points. He also grabbed 3 rebounds, dished out 9 assists and blocked one shot.

NSIC Tournament Tie-Breaking Criteria

Tie-Breaker The tie-breaking criteria for seeding into the NSIC postseason tournament will be as follows. (Note: The formula will be used to break one tie at a time. Once a team is seeded via the following tiebreaker, the formula will repeat itself from the beginning to determine any additional seeding for the tournament due to ties in the conference standings. The formula will be used to break the highest-seeded tie first according to the conference standings). [updated with women's criteria]

- A. Final NSIC standings
- B. Head to head competition only if the teams involved played twice as conference games. If two teams play only once, but the visiting team wins on the home team's floor.
- C. Team with the higher conference only opponents winning percentage. Take all 20 conference teams played winning percentage add them up and divide by 20 conference games.
- D. Common opponent, common site.
