

BEMIDJI STATE VOLLEYBALL

2009 Outlook



The 2009 Bemidji State University volleyball team is a year older, a year more experienced and head coach **Laurie Bitter** thinks that might be just what the Beavers need to push them to the next level. With four returning starters off the 2008 squad, including two juniors who enter their third years as starters, Bemidji State hopes that experience boosts the Beavers to the next level.

"They are hungry on the court," Bitter said. "People will say we are a young team, but to me we are an experienced team compared to what we were last year when we threw them out on to the court when they weren't ready to leave the diapers yet. We are experienced mentally, emotionally and physically, and we are much more ready than last year."

Coupled with that experience is a talented incoming class. With four newcomers competing for playing time, Bemidji State will have depth at every position that the squad has lacked in recent history.

Bitter begins her third year at the helm of the women's volleyball program. She spent 16 years as the head volleyball coach at Lake of the Woods High School before taking over the program in 2007. Graduate Assistant Coach **Richelle Richardson** is in her second season after coming to Bemidji State from Harlan Community High School. The Beavers also welcome two new volunteer assistant coaches, **Casey Campbell** and **Kris Moulton**.

Without a senior on the roster the Beavers will look to their junior class for leadership that features the return of **Brie Groskreutz** who sat out all but three matches last fall due to a broken finger. Bemidji State's junior class is also highlighted by the return of **Nicole Olson** and **Lindsey Weyer** with the addition of junior college transfer **Nicole Solum** from Spokane Falls Community College.

Olson and Weyer combined to start 40 matches and saw time in a total of 170 sets in 2008, while Solum helped lead the Bigfoot to a 30-20 record being named the team's *Most Valuable Player* (MVP) and first team all-conference.

Sophomores **Courtney Bitter** and **Jessi-Beth McCannell** played in all 31 matches with Bitter seeing time in all 103 sets while McCannell was second on the team with 101 sets played as true freshmen, and will be looked to have a larger role this year. Unfortunately, McCannell came down with mono before the season started and will miss the first four-six weeks of the season.

After a successful spring season, the Beaver volleyball team seems to be building the chemistry that is the recipe for success.

"Last year we had a very young team and with some changes last spring we decided to bring some more defensive kids in," Bitter said. "I'm a defensive coach and I spent a lot of time on ball control and defense. Offense doesn't win championships, it's defense, so we are on our way to being a strong defensive team in the is conference."

SETTERS

Bemidji State's performance this season will be dictated by Bitter. Already ninth in Bemidji State history with 884 career assists (most assists by a freshman in at least five seasons) Bitter is on the verge of establishing herself as one of the best setters in program history. She was also second in digs (252), fourth in blocks (24) and service aces (18), and fifth in kills

(120) and attacks (404). Bitter was named to the *2008 Las Vegas Blast All-Tournament Team*.

"She brings experience in setting and that speed with the offensive and with our hitters," Bitter said. "She hustles and won't let the ball drop. She works hard."

Providing depth at the setter position is sophomore McCannell. The 2008 leader in digs as a freshman for the Beavers (341), McCannell was also third on the team with 35 set assists.

OUTSIDE HITTER

After suffering a season ending injury in 2008, junior **Brie Groskreutz** will look to build off a solid 2007 season in which she was first on the team with 455 digs (4.79 d/s) and fourth on the team with 209 kills (2.20 k/s). Along with providing an offensive punch, Groskreutz will see a lot of time in the back row for BSU this season to help solidify the Beavers' defense.

"She is a defensive player that will play a lot of the back row this year," Bitter said. "She just digs up everything."

Sophomore **Melissa McNeely** and saw time in the starting rotation for the Beavers last season. McNeely appeared in 27 matches with 16 starts and showed continued improvements during the course of the 2008 season. She was fourth in kills (137) and third in service aces (21) for BSU last season with 123 digs.

"McNeely got a lot of playing time as a freshman and will be pushing for that position to get on the floor," Bitter said.

Junior **Lindsey Weyer** could also see valuable time at the outside hitter position as she wrapped up her sophomore campaign with 88 kills, 114 digs and 12 blocks.

"She is starting to play some really good volleyball and is a leader, a hard worker and her game is getting better and better," Bitter said.

MIDDLE BLOCKERS/RIGHT SIDE HITTERS

Olson established herself as the Beavers' go-to player in the middle of 2008. For the second straight season she led BSU in kills as she racked up 239. In addition to her offense, Olson's defense also improved as she played all six rotations last season and recorded back-to-back matches with at least 10 kills and 10 digs. This year, Bitter looks for Olson's improvement to continue now that the junior has two full years under her belt.

"She is a very explosive player," Bitter said. "Her biggest thing will be to stay focused, confident and getting the blocks and hits down."

Sophomore **Laura Slinger** played last season as an outside hitter but will be moved to the middle this season. She showed improvements during the course of her freshman slate as she pounded down 96 kills with 92 digs and 19 blocks.

"Slinger has moved back to the middle," Bitter said. "She is a small middle but a very quick."

Also looking for time at the middle blocker and right side hitter position this season is sophomore **Kimberly Hacker**. Last season, Hacker saw time in 49 sets, providing reserve duty as a middle blocker. A tall player with a long reach, Hacker will look to provide defensive support at the net. Also bidding for a starting role at the right side hitter position is junior college transfer, Solum, who joined the Beavers in the spring of 2009.

"Nicole is my only lefty," Bitter said. "She is a good player, a finesse player."

DEFENSIVE SPECIALISTS/LIBERO

The Beavers return their top backcourt performer from the 2008 season, while adding a one newcomer who will have a chance to contribute. Returning at the libero position is McCannell, a true freshman a year ago, who led the 2008 squad with 341 digs. She averaged 3.38 digs per set and was second on the team with 24 service aces.

Joining McCannell in the backcourt will be defensive specialist **Samantha Hertaus**, a freshman from New Prague, Minn. Hertaus joined the BSU volleyball team in the spring of 2009, after transferring from Marquette University. She was a three-time Missota All-Conference performer on the volleyball court and was named to the *Farmington Tournament All-Tournament* team twice during her high school career.

SCHEDULE

The Beavers will open the schedule with three road tournaments in the first three weeks participating in the UNK Fall Classic (host Nebraska-Kearney in Kearney, Neb.), Florida Southern Classic (host Florida Southern in Tampa, Fla.) and Concordia University Tournament (host Concordia University in St. Paul, Minn.). Bemidji State will also play its traditional 20-match Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference schedule, providing the Beavers with 13 matches against Division II NCAA Tournament participants from the 2008 season and a mid-season clash with Division I North Dakota.

"Our conference is the toughest in the nation," Bitter said. "Our schedule is very intense. We don't get a break in a weekend. We hope to do well in the tournaments and get the experience we need to play in our conference."

GOALS

"Our goal this year is to gain respect," Bitter said. "I tell the team, 'if you want respect you have to earn it.' We set a goal for our team and hopefully at the end of the season I can say we achieved it."

"I've always been the underdog coach in a little town trying to make it in the big world, and I've done it. Bemidji is a little town trying to make it in a big world, so that is what we are going to try and do."

"We have to learn how to win matches and learn not to stop three-fourths into a game," Bitter said. "They want to smash that No. 11 preseason ranking and move up the polls."
