• Bemidji State will play host to St. Cloud State on Friday at 7:07 p.m. and on Saturday at 2:07 p.m.

• Last time out the Beavers took four points from Minnesota State down in Mankato. The last time the Beavers earned four points over a weekend while on the road was on Dec. 16-17, 2006 against North Dakota.

• The Beavers went into their second shootout of the season on Friday after a 2-2 draw with the Mavericks. **Annie Bauerfeld** scored with 0.4 seconds left in the game to send it into overtime. The shootout was a barnburner, seeing 26 shooters participate before a victor was declared.

• On Saturday the Beavers penalty kill was out in force, stopping seven of the right Maverick power plays. Erin Johnson scored the game winner and an empty-netter to secure the win for Bemidji State.

Head Coach Steve Sertich



Steve Sertich enters his fourth season at Bemidji State. In his first season Sertich led the Beavers to an 11-20-5 overall record and a 9-15-4 record in Western Collegiate Hockey Association (WCHA) play, good for a sixth-place finish. The 22 points he garnered during that first year was the most points Bemidji State has earned in conference play in its nine-year Division I era. He also led the Beavers to

its second win over the University of Minnesota in school history with a 2-0 shutout that was televised on Fox Sports Net North. Bemidji State compiled a six-game unbeaten streak, the longest unbeaten streak for the Beavers since the 2001-02 season.

Last year, coach Sertich compiled a 4-29-3 record and a 1-25-2 mark in the WCHA. The team recorded another shutout over a powerhouse, when the Beavers tied the then No. 2-ranked University of Wisconsin Badgers. This was the highest-ranked opponent to ever be shut out by a BSU squad.

Sertich came to Bemidji State University after spending 13 years as the head varsity coach at Roseville Area High School. He coached the Roseville boys' team from 1993-2003, leading it to a 156-71-11 record and two Minnesota State tournament appearances. Under Sertich's guidance, Roseville finished third in the 2002 tournament and second in 2003. He led Roseville to Suburban East Conference Championships in 2002 and 2003. Sertich earned four Coach of the Year honors, as he was named Section 3AA boys' Coach of the Year in 1999, Section 2AA Boys' Coach of the Year in both 2002 and 2003, and Class AA Coach of the Year in 2003.

In 2003, Sertich moved to head coach of the Roseville girls' varsity team and in three seasons led the program to a record of 62-21-2. The Roseville girls finished fourth in the 2006 state tournament and captured Suburban East Conference titles in both '04 and '05. Sertich was named the 2004 Section 2AA Girls' Coach of the Year. Sertich began his coaching career in 1976 as the head boys' varsity coach at Northfield (Minn.) High School, and over the next 20 years he would hold a variety of head and assistant coaching positions at the high school, college and national levels.

Sertich began his playing career with the Colorado College Tigers in 1970 and assembled a standout four-year career.

Sertich was a member of the U.S. National Team from 1973-75, and played on a team which trained in Bemidji. He was also a member of the 1976 U.S. Olympic team, which finished fifth at the Innsbruck, Austria games.

He also played two years in the German Professional League, spending the 1974-75 season as captain for Fussen and two seasons from 1978-80 playing for Nurnburg.

Scouting St. Cloud State

- St. Cloud State earned a series split against #5 Minnesota Duluth on Friday and Saturday, Nov. 6-7, in the National Hockey Center.
- The Huskies relied on their top lines and goaltending to upset the No. 5 UMD Bulldogs on Friday by a score of 5-1. Senior Holly Roberts netted two goals, while junior netminder Ashley Nixon stopped 31 of 32 UMD shots in the win.
- On Saturday the Bulldogs returned the favor to SCSU, shutting out the Huskies 5-0 to earn the series split. Minnesota Duluth went 3-1-0 against the Huskies this season.
- Holly Roberts (SCSU) netted her first two goals of the season against UMD on Friday. The St. Cloud native is now tied for 6th on the all-time scoring list at SCSU with 85 points (35G, 50 A) in 122 games played.
- Caitlin Hogan tabbed an assist last weekend to bring her career points total to 95 (41g, 54a) in 122 games played. The senior center is in quest to become just the second player in school history to chart 100 career points in the Cardinal and Black.
- Team captain Felicia Nelson (St. Paul) tallied two more points this season with a goal and an assist against the Bulldogs. The St. Paul native now has six points (4g, 2a) in seven games played in 2009-10.

Series against St. Cloud State

- In recent years the Huskies have had a lot of success going 8-0-2 against the Beavers. The last win against St. Cloud State for Bemidji State came on Oct. 14, 2006.
- However, last season's home game on Feb. 13, 2009 against the Huskies ended in a 3-3 draw with the Beavers coming out with the shootout win.
- Besides last year's 3-3 tie, the three other games ended with scorelines of 0-2, 0-2, and 1-4.
- The only current Beavers that have scored goals against the Huskies are Annie Bauerfeld (1G), Erin Johnson (3G) and Nicole Rawlings (2G).

Tremendous Trio

- **Erin Cody** (For., Roseville, Minn.) (2G, 4A), **Erin Johnson** (For., Farmington, Minn.) (7G, 3A), and **Annie Bauerfeld** (For., Woodbury, Minn.) (2G, 6A) have accounted for 46 percent of the offensive production so far this season for the Beavers.
- Five of Johnson's goals have come on the power play.
- All three game-winning goals have come from the trio, two from Johnson (vs. Mercyhurst, Oct. 30 & vs. Minnesota State, Nov. 7) and one from Bauerfeld (vs Wisconsin, Oct. 16).

Slovakian Sensation

- Beaver goaltender **Zuzana Tomcikova** (So, Bratislava, Slovakia) has made one appearance this season gathering 236 saves on 254 shots. She currently has a .929 save percentage on the season while recording a 2.24 goals against average.
- In the second shootout of the season for the Beavers, Tomcikova stopped 11 of 13 shooters to help BSU claim the extra point from the shootout win against Minnesota State on Nov. 6, 2009.
- Her shutout against Wisconsin on Oct. 10, 2009 was the second time Bemidji State has recorded a shutout against the Badgers.
- She was named *WCHA Defensive Player of the Week* for the week of Oct.14-20. She now has a total of four defensive player of the week awards after garnering three in a row last year.
- Tomcikova will be playing for the Slovakian National Women's Hockey Team in the 2010 Winter Olympics in Vancouver.
- Her success on the ice last year didn't go unnoticed as she was the first player in

- Robertson's physical game makes it tough for opposing players to beat her on the rush. Her intimidating style of play helps bog down opposing breakouts and creates turnovers for the Beavers.
- Sisters and defensive linemates **Erika Wheelhouse** (Fr., Crookston, Minn.) and **Marlee Wheelhouse** (So., Crookston, Minn.) recorded a total of 32 blocks over the weekends against Wisconsin and Ohio State. Including a total of 15 blocked shots in the 1-0 shutout against the Badgers.
- Erika Wheelhouse has also notched five assists so far this season, which leads all defenders.

Sharing the Wealth

- The Beavers have 13 players who have recorded points so far this season.
- The 13 players have combined to score 52 points for BSU.

Squeaky clean

- While playing in every game so far this season, senior captain **Franny Dorr** (Roseville, Minn.) has yet to earn a trip to the penalty box.
- Dorr is fourth on the team in scoring, with three goals and two assists.
- In 113 games, she has only compiled 29 penalties for 58 PIMs, roughly averaging one penalty for every four
