



# BEMIDJI STATE HOCKEY

## GAME 8 - ALASKA ANCHORAGE AT BEMIDJI STATE

Sanford Center • Bemidji, Minn. • November 13, 2010 • 7:07 p.m.

### Bemidji State notables:

►Despite Bemidji State's highest scoring output of the season, four goals, the team fell to Alaska Anchorage, 5-4, last night and dropped to 1-5-1 on the season. Contrary to most of BSU's first six contests, the Beavers got balanced scoring from their line up as nine players logged their name in the scoring column.

►Alaska Anchorage takes a 1-0-0 lead in the all-time series.

►BSU is now winless through its first five home games (0-4-1) of 2010-11. The last time the Beavers opened the home portion of their season without a win for as long, was their first season in existence. In 1947, a campaign that is not included in BSU's official hockey records, the green and white went 0-4-1 at home.

►A change in official scoring took place last night after the game. **Jordan George** was credited with an assist on the Beavers' second goal of the evening (0:42) and should read: **Matt Read** from George and **Brad Hunt**.

►With an assist last night, sophomore forward **Jordan George** now leads BSU with 10 points (4-6=10) and has registered a point in six of the Beavers' first seven games. He ranks 18th in the country on the points per game list (1.43).

►Three BSU players posted multi-point games versus the Seawolves last night. **Matt Read** (2-0=2), **Shea Walters** (0-2=2) and **Brad Hunt** (0-2=2) each netted two points. Read's was his second of 2010-11 and his team-leading 32nd of his career, while it stood as the 19th for Hunt and the sixth for Walters.

►With two goals last night, **Matt Read** posted just the fifth multi-goal game of his career. The senior now leads the team with five goals and sits locked in a tie for 12th in the country averaging 0.43 goals per game.

►**Brad Hunt's** first assist of the evening stood as his 70th point at BSU. In 85 games, the defenseman has logged 16-55=71 points. He also bypassed Marty Goulet, Rob Sirianni and Riley Riddell to sit alone in fifth place on the BSU Division I scoring list with 55 assists leading all blueliners since 1999-2000.

►With 0-6=6 points this season, **Brad Hunt** ranks 14th in the nation among blueliners.

►Saturday's contests stands as the 100th for senior alternate captain **Ryan Adams**. A transfer to BSU the disbanding Wayne State University hockey program after the 2007-08 season, Adams has piled up 3-15=18 collegiate points from his blueline position.

►With an assist last night, **Matt Read** climbed to within one helper from the BSU Division I-era mark for career assists (68). He currently ranks third behind Andrew Murray (2001-05) and Luke Erickson (2003-07) who share the top spot with 69.

►**Matt Read** potted his 47th and 48th career goals last night and is now tied for third on BSU's Division I era goal scoring list with Ron Sirianni (2003-07) and Tyler Scofield (2005-09) in third place. He remains four goals from matching Luke Erickson in the No. 2 spot (52).

►With 116 points (48-68=116) **Matt Read** surpassed Andrew Murray (2001-05), who logged 46-69=115 points as a Beaver before moving on to the NHL, on BSU's Division I scoring list. Read is now just five points from matching BSU great Luke Erickson (2003-07) atop BSU's Division I scoring list (52-69=121).

►The Beavers got good offensive help from its defense last night. Five defenders had at least one point, including a rare assist from BSU goaltender **Dan Bakala**.

►Bakala's assist stands as the second of his career. Bakala's last assist came versus Minnesota State Dec. 11, 2009.

►Freshman **Sam Rendle** and Radoslav Illo each posted their first collegiate goals last night. Fellow rookies **Jeff Jubinville**, **Anton Racklin** and **Garrett Ladd** are all still in search of their first collegiate points. Veterans **Matt Carlson** (0-1=1), **Drew Fisher** (0-4=4) and **Jake Areshenko** (0-4=4) are also looking for their first collegiate goals.

►Despite out shooting its opponent for the first time this season last night, 34-23, Bemidji State has been out shot 223-151 this season and has out shot its opponent only once in its first seven games.

►Allowing five goals in last night's contest, BSU has now conceded five-or-more goals five times this season. Allowing an average of 3.86 goals per game, BSU's defense is ranked 54th in the nation.

►BSU's penalty-kill unit has now allowed 12 power-play goals on 42 opponent chances (.714) to sit 55th in the nation.

►**Brad Hunt** continues to be a force on the Beavers power-play. He leads the team in power-play point production posting five of his six assists on the man advantage.

►The Beavers posted a record of 10-6-3 a year ago when playing on Saturday and are 1-2-1 in 2010-11.

►BSU has compiled an all-time record of 967-473-87 (.662) in 1,527 games.
