## GAME 12 - NORTHERN MICHIGAN AT BEMIDJI STATE

Bemidji Regional Event Center • Bemidji, Minn. • November 26, 2010 • 7:07 p.m.

### Bemidji State notables:

► Bemidji State's 4-0 loss to the Northern Michigan last night leaves the Beavers winless on Fridays (0-6-0) as they fall to 2-8-1 overall.

► The BSU-Northern Michigan series is now tied a 1-1-1 since its beginning in 2009-10.

► BSU's 4-0 loss to NMU last night marks the first time since Jan. 2, 2010--a streak spanning 30 games--that BSU has been held without a goal. Jan. 2, BSU and Western Michigan skated to a rare 0-0 tie.

► BSU looks for a win tonight to avoid being swept for the third time this season. The Beavers were last swept in back-to-to-back series by North Dakota (Jan. 2-3) and Minnesota Duluth (Jan. 16-17) during the 2008-09 season.

► After an empty-net goal by Tyler Gron ice the game last night the Beavers have now allowed an empty-net goal in six of its eight losses.

► The Beavers' top line of **Matt Read**, **Jordan George** and **Ian Lowe** have been a scoring force for BSU this season accounting for 49 percent of BSU's total scoring (33 pts), 16 of 24 goals (67%) and 17 of 43 assists (40%). Last night the trio was held without a point marking just the third game this season the Beavers' most potent line has been held scoreless.

► The Beavers' top line for the last two seasons has predominantly been made up by **Matt Read**, **Jordan George** and **Ian Lowe**. Tonight the trio will be separated for just the second time since sophomore George has been at BSU. In 45 games, the line has piled up 69 goals and 70 assists for 139 points. The last time the trio was separated was Jan. 16, 2010. **Brance Orban** was substituted for George and netted two goals and an assist to lead the Beavers to a 4-3 victory at Niagara.

► Freshman **Sam Rendle** leads all BSU blueliners in goal scoring and tops the BSU rookies scoring list with 3-1=4 points. **Matt Read** (7-5=12) and **Jordan George** (4-8=12) share top spot on BSU's 2010-11 scoring list with 12 points apiece.

► **Matt Read** has scored seven goals in the first 11 games of 2010-11--a stat that places him 24th in the country in goals per game (0.64).

► With 0-8=8 points this season, **Brad Hunt** ranks 24th in the nation among blueliners averaging 0.73 points per game.

► With 120 points (50-70=120) **Matt Read** sits just one point from matching BSU great Luke Erickson (2003-07) atop BSU's Division I scoring list (52-69=121). In addition, he is tied with Bruce Falk (1967-71) on BSU career scoring list.

► The Beavers' defense was held without a point last night for just the third contest of the season, snapping a four-game scoring streak by the blue line. The BSU blueliners have contributed 3-16-19 points (1.73 ppg) in the Beavers' first 11 games of 2010-11.

► Last night the Beavers out shot the Wildcats 37-25 marking just the games this season in which the Beavers have out shot their opponents. On the season, BSU opponents hold a 297-244. The team's 37 shots on goal marks its largest shot total since a 6-1 victory over Niagara Feb. 20, 2010--a streak spanning 19 games.

► Freshman **Kyle Brodie** made his debut in the green and white last night. He finished with two shots on net and a blocked shot, while he posted an even plus/minus rating.

► Three seems to be a magical thresh hold for BSU opponents in 2010-11. BSU is 0-8-0, including a 4-0 loss to NMU last night, when its opponents have scored three or more goals in a game. BSU is 2-0-1 when holding its opponents to two or fewer goals this season.

► Rookies **Kyle Brodie**, **Jeff Jubinville**, **Anton Racklin** and **Garrett Ladd** are all still in search of their first collegiate points. Veterans **Matt Carlson** (0-1=1), **Drew Fisher** (0-4=4) and **Jake Areshenko** (0-4=4) are looking for their first collegiate goals.

► BSU's penalty-kill unit has allowed 13 power-play goals on 60 opponent chances (.783) to sit 41st in the nation, but the unit has been lights out as of late. Since Nov. 6, BSU has snuffed out 27 of its opponents' last 30 power-play opportunities (.900), which includes holding the opposition scoreless on the man advantage in four of its last six games.

► **Brad Hunt** continues to be a force on the Beavers power-play. He leads the team in power-play point production posting six of his eight assists on the man advantage.

► **Matt Read** will make his 121 consecutive appearance for the Beavers tonight. Read has not missed a game since he stepped on campus at BSU in the fall of 2007. He remains 22 games behind Matt Pope and John Haider for the BSU Division I-era record for games played (143). **Brad Hunt**, who is also set to play tonight, has been in the Beavers' line up 85 straight games to rank second on the team.

► The Beavers posted a record of 10-6-3 a year ago when playing on Saturday and are 2-3-1 in 2010-11.

► BSU has compiled an all-time record of 968-476-87 (.662) in 1,531 games.
