Bemidji State notables:

► Bemidji State and Colorado College played to a 5-5 overtime tie last night. The extra time contest marks the Beavers' ninth overtime game of the season and its sixth in the last nine games. BSU is now 2-3-4 in 2010-11 overtime contests, 7-12-4 in WCHA play and 11-14-4 overall.

► The Beavers have struggled in Friday evening contests in 2010-11. Last night's series-opening tie makes BSU 3-9-3 (.300) on Fridays with just one win (1-8-2/.181) in league play Friday.

► BSU is 20-20-42 in overtime since the 1999-2000 season. The Beavers have escaped overtime with at least a tie in over 76-percent (62-of-82) of overtime affairs in the last 11 seasons.

► The Beavers have three overtime losses in eight extra time games (2-3-3) this season, which matches BSU teams of 2002-03, 2004-05 and 2005-06 for the BSU Division I-era mark for OT losses in a season (3).

► Four Beavers recorded at least two points last night, led by a season-high three-point effort from **Ian Lowe**. The senior scored a goal and matched a career-best two assists in the tie.

► With his first career game-tying goal last night, **Jordan George** has now scored the deciding goal in three of the Beavers' last four games. He scored the game-winner in a 4-1 win at Minnesota State (Feb. 5) and added another in last Saturday's 1-0 victory at Michigan Tech.

► Defenseman **Brad Hunt** is quickly developing an affinity for piling up points at Sanford Center. He has 1-16=17 points to rank fourth on the team in scoring, but 75 percent of that, 0-12=12, has come on home ice. He is currently tied with **Jordan George** and **Matt Read** with a team-high 12 points at home.

► Sophomore forward **Jordan George** posted an assist to go with his career-high 14th goal of the season last night. He leads the Beavers with 14-17=31 points to sit just three points from a career-high in points scored (34).

► BSU's five-goal offensive explosion marks the highest goal-scoring output of the season and the most goals in a single game since the Beavers posted 6-1 victory over Niagara nearly a year ago--Feb. 20, 2010.

► The BSU blueline accounted for four assists last night and has contributed seven assists in the Beavers' last three games. The last time the BSU "D" posted at least four points was a 5-4 loss to Alaska Anchorage (Nov. 12). The Beavers' blueline unit has contributed at least a point in 10 of BSU's last 12 games and has averaged 2.00 points per game (1-23=24) during that stretch.

► Twenty-seven games into the 2010-11 campaign, the Beavers already have nine games that have been extended to overtime surpassing its 2009-10 total (8). BSU has played more OT games only one season since making the jump to NCAA Division I for the 1999-2000 season. In 2002-03 the Beavers played 15 OT contests.

► Three seems to be a magical threshold for BSU opponents in 2010-11. Until last night, BSU had been held without a point in the standings (0-9-0/.000) when its opponents have scored three or more goals in a game. BSU is 11-3-3 (.735) when holding its opponents to two or fewer goals this season.

► Twenty-three of BSU's 26 skaters have netted at least a point this season. Rookie **Jeff Jubinville** netted his first collegiate point last night with a goal in the second period. Fellow newcomers **Anton Racklin** and **Garrett Ladd** along with sophomore **Matt Hartmann** are all still in search of their first collegiate points.

► The BSU power-play has struggled to get on track in the second half of 2010-11. In the first 13 games back from break. Beavers have only seven goals on the man advantage (7-for-36) and are clicking at just 19.4 percent. Last night's power-play goal by **Matt Read** midway through the first period snapped a streak of 93:40 without a goal on the man advantage--a streak spanning four games.

► BSU's penalty-kill unit was 1-for-2 last night. The Beavers have now allowed just four man advantage goals in their last nine games and 38 opponent chances (.895). The unit has held opponents scoreless on 107-of-132 opponent man advantage opportunities this season (.810).

► **Matt Read** will make his 140 consecutive appearance for the Beavers tonight. Read has not missed a game since he stepped on campus at BSU in the fall of 2007. He remains three games behind Matt Pope and John Haider for the BSU Division I-era record for games played (143).

► Jordan George has five goals and two assists for seven points in the Beavers' last five games.

► BSU posted 27 shots last night to take a 27-21 edge in the shots on goal. The game marked the third consecutive game the Beavers have out shot their opponents. That might not sound like much, but considering BSU has been out shot 17 times in 2010-11, has been out shot 827-740 overall, and 674-560 in league play this season, its a small victory.

► On its current four-game unbeaten streak (2-0-2), the Beavers have garnered six of eight league points. The four-game streak is BSU's longest since it won four straight from Feb. 13-26, 2010. The last time the team was unbeaten in more than four was an eight-game string to open the 2009-10 campaign (7-0-1).

► Last night's stalemate left Bemidji State trailing Colorado College in the all-time series, 1-3-1. The Tigers are unbeaten in the last three meetings between the teams. BSU's last win versus CC came Dec. 29, 2006 in a 3-2 games in Colorado Springs, Colo.

► The Beavers posted a record of 10-6-3 a year ago when playing on Saturday and are 8-5-1 overall and 6-4-1 in Saturday league games in 2010-11.

► BSU has compiled an all-time record of 977-482-90 (.660) in 1,549 games.
