GAME 32 - BEMIDJI STATE AT (1) NORTH DAKOTA

Ralph Engelstad Arena • Grand Forks, N.D. • February 27, 2011 • 3:37 p.m.

Bemidji State notables:

► Bemidji State was defeated by North Dakota 5-2 yesterday afternoon. BSU is now 8-13-4 in WCHA play and 12-15-4 overall. With just three regular-season games and a best-of-three play-off series ahead, BSU needs to win out if it is to stand a chance of extending its current streak of nine straight seasons with a record of .500 or better.

► The Beavers have struggled in Friday evening contests in 2010-11. Last night's series-opening loss makes BSU 3-10-3 (.281) on Fridays with just one win (1-9-2/.167) in Friday league play.

► BSU falling to No. 1 North Dakota yesterday brings the Beavers' record versus the nation's top team 1-5-0 since making the jump to the NCAA Division I level (1999-2000). The last time BSU knocked off the top-ranked team was a 3-2 victory over Miami (Ohio) Nov. 27, 2009 right here at Ralph Engelstad Arena.

► In 2010-11 the Beavers have played 12 games against teams holding down one of the nation's top 15 rankings and are 4-6-2 versus those teams. After going 0-5-1 versus nationally-ranked competition during the first two months of 2010-11, the Beavers are 4-1-1 versus the top 15 since Dec. 3.

Since the Beavers made the jump to the NCAA Division I ranks, BSU is 11-43-4 (.228) versus teams in the top-15. With that said, BSU is now 9-8-2 (.526) versus the top 15 since the beginning of the 2008-09 campaign.

► The Beavers have three overtime losses in eight extra time games (2-3-3) this season, which matches BSU teams of 2002-03, 2004-05 and 2005-06 for the BSU Division I-era mark for OT losses in a season (3).

► This season, the Fighting Sioux have defeated the Beavers three times to assure UND of winning the four-game seasons series. Ironically, each of UND's wins over BSU have come by the score of 5-2.

► Senior forward **Ryan Cramer** scored his second goal of the season yesterday. Cramer, who has 2-6=8 points this season, has three points (2-1=3) in BSU's last two outings. The goal was Cramer's 40th collegiate point.

► **Matt Read** scored his team-leading 17th goal of 2010-11 yesterday. It was Read's third short-handed goal of the season and his ninth shorthy in the green and white. He is currently tied with Brendan Cook (9) for the top spot in the BSU Division I-era record book for career short-handed markers.

► Seniors **Matt Read** and **Ian Lowe** combined for the Beavers' second goal yesterday giving each player a point in each of BSU's games versus UND this season. Read has two goals and an assist, while Lowe has contributed a goal and two assists.

► Read now has 17-12=29 points as a senior and trails only **Jordan George**, who has 14=17=31 points, for BSU's scoring lead. With another point, Read will crack the 30-point plateau for the third consecutive season. The last BSU player to post more than 30 points in three consecutive seasons was Luke Erickson from 2003-04 to 2005-06.

► Thirty-one games into the 2010-11 campaign, the Beavers already have nine games that have been extended to overtime. BSU has played more OT games only one season since the 1999-2000 season. The 2002-03 Beavers played 15 OT contests.

► Three seems to be a magical threshold for BSU opponents in 2010-11. BSU has gained just one point in the WCHA in the standings (0-10-1/.045) when its opponents have scored three or more goals in a game. BSU is 12-3-3 (.750) when holding its opponents to two or fewer goals this season.

► Twenty-three of BSU's 26 skaters have netted at least a point this season. Rookie **Jeff Jubinville** netted his first collegiate point Feb. 18 with a goal. Fellow newcomers **Anton Racklin** and **Garrett Ladd** along with sophomore **Matt Hartmann** are all still in search of their first collegiate points.

► BSU was held without a goal on three power-play opportunities yesterday. The BSU power-play has struggled to get on track in the second half of 2010-11. In the first 17 games back from break. Beavers have only nine goals on the man advantage (9-for-43) and are clicking at just 20 percent. BSU's last power-play goal came 85:15 of game time back off the stick of Jamie MacQueen in the second period of BSU's Feb. 19.

► Entering yesterday's series opener, the Beavers' penalty-kill had allowed just five man advantage goals in their last 10 games and 43 opponent chances (.884). But last night, the unit conceded three UND power-play markers matching a season-high for power-play goals allowed. In 2010-11, the unit has held opponents scoreless on 117-of-144 opponent man advantage opportunities this season (.812).

► **Matt Read** will make his 142nd consecutive appearance for the Beavers this afternoon. Read has not missed a game since he stepped on campus at BSU in the fall of 2007. He remains just one game from matching Matt Pope and John Haider for the BSU Division I-era record for games played (143).

► Yesterday BSU was out shot 33-15. BSU's 15 shots on goal total was just one shy of a season-low (14) set in the season-opener (Oct. 15) versus UND. BSU has been out shot 19 times in 2010-11, has been out shot 895-772 overall, and 742-592 in league play this season.

► Yesterday afternoon's win by UND marked the Fighting Sioux's 11th consecutive win in the series as UND increases its lead in the rivalry to 20-1-1.

► The last time the Beavers defeated North Dakota was Feb. 7, 1970 (7-5) in Grand Forks, N.D.

► The Beavers posted a record of 10-6-3 a year ago when playing on Saturday and are 9-5-1 (.633) overall and 7-4-1 (.625) in Saturday league games in 2010-11.

► BSU has compiled an all-time record of 978-483-90 (.660) in 1,551 games.
