GAME 36 - BEMIDJI STATE AT (12) NEBRASKA-OMAHA

Bemidji State notables:

► Bemidji State, the 10-seed, earned its first WCHA playoff victory last night defeating third-seeded Nebraska-Omaha 4-2. The Beavers improved to 13-17-5 overall. A win tonight in the best-of-three format would secure BSU's debut in the WCHA Red Baron Final Five next weekend in St. Paul, Minn.

► The Beavers have struggled in Friday evening contests in 2010-11. Last night's series-opening win makes BSU 4-10-4 (.333) on Fridays with just one win (1-9-3/192) in Friday league play. However, BSU is 2-0-1 vs. UNO in the first game of a series.

► The Beavers already have 11 games that have been extended to overtime in 2010-11. BSU has played more OT games only one season since making the jump to NCAA Division I for the 1999-2000 season. The 2002-03 Beavers played 15 OT contests. BSU's five ties this season match 2005-06 for second most ties in BSU's Division I-era behind only 2002-03 (8).

► The Beavers have four overtime losses in 11 extra time games (2-4-5) this season, which establishes a new BSU Division I-era mark for OT losses in a season.

► In 2010-11, the Beavers have played 14 games against teams holding down one of the nation's top 15 sports in the rankings. BSU is 5-7-2 versus the nation's top 15 this season. After going 0-5-1 versus nationally-ranked competition during the first two months of 2010-11, the Beavers are 5-2-1 versus the top 15 since Dec. 3.

Since the Beavers made the jump to the NCAA Division I ranks, BSU is 12-44-4 (.233) versus teams in the top-15. With that said, BSU is now 10-9-2 (.524) versus the top 15 since the beginning of 2008-09.

► Sophomore **Jordan George** ended his two-game scoring drought last night recording a goal and an assist. His eighth multi-point effort of the season gives him a team-leading 15-18-34 points and equals his rookie scoring total.

► **Jordan George** has been a Maverick wrangler over the past two seasons. In seven career games versus UNO, the sophomore has 2-6=8 points to lead all BSU players and owns a +5 plus/minus rating.

► **Matt Read** returned from injury to post a +3 plus/minus rating and record his team-leading 19th goal of 2010-11--a mark equalling his career-high for goals set a year ago.

► Netting last night's game-winner **Jamie MacQueen** now has three game-winning goals on five goals scored this season. He is tied with **Jordan George** for the team's lead (3).

► **Ian Lowe** scored his team-leading third unassisted goal of the season last night.

► Fifteen of the Beavers' last 21 games of the season have been played away from Sanford Center. With that said, BSU is 6-9-2 on the road this season and are 6-4-3 on the road since Jan. 7.

► The Beavers' got an assist from its blueline unit last night. BSU defenders have now posted 10-43=53 points, have contributed scoring in 25 of the BSU's 35 games and are averaging 1.56 points per game.

► Three seems to be a magical thresh hold for BSU opponents in 2010-11. BSU is 13-3-3 (.750) when holding its opponents to two or fewer goals this season and gained just two points in the WCHA in the standings (0-10-2 /.083), a pair of ties, when its opponents scored three or more goals in a game.

► Twenty-three of BSU's 26 skaters have netted at least a point this season. Rookie **Jeff Jubinville** netted his first collegiate point Feb. 18 with a goal. Fellow newcomers **Anton Racklin** and **Garrett Ladd** along with sophomore **Matt Hartmann** are all still in search of their first collegiate points.

► Despite owning the third-most efficient power-play unit in the league (.212), BSU has managed just four power-play goals in its last nine games and 26 man advantage opportunities (.153).

► The BSU penalty-kill was tested last night, but managed to snuff out four of the Mavericks' five power-play opportunities. In 2010-11, the unit has held opponents scoreless on 127-of-160 opponent man advantage opportunities this season (.794).

► **Matt Read** made his 144th appearance for the Beavers last night surpassing Matt Pope and John Haider for the BSU Division I-era record for games played.

► Last night the Beavers were out shot by UNO 48-17. The 31-shot deficit stands as the first 30-shot differential since BSU was out shot 45-15 in a NCAA Midwest Regional semifinal 4-0 loss to Wisconsin (3/25/06).

► BSU has been out shot 22 times in 35 games in 2010-11 and has been out shot 1,049-872 this season.

► The Beavers have allowed 95 shots in the last two games along, but **Dan Bakala** has been up to the challenge posting back-to-back career-high save totals--44 versus Minnesota March 5 and 46 last night. The last BSU goaltender to record 45 or more stops in a game was Matt Clime (45) in a 4-3 overtime loss to Denver in the semifinal of the 2005 NCAA Northeast Regional (3/26/2005).

► Unbeaten versus UNO (4-0-1) this season, BSU has recorded over 30 percent of its season total of 13 wins versus the Mavericks. Conversely, with an overall record of 21-14-2, 29 percent of UNO's losses have come to BSU.

► The BSU/UNO all-time series is now tied at 5-5-1 while, the Mavericks hold a 5-3-1 advantage at Quest Center.

► The Beavers are 9-7-1 (.594) on Saturday in 2010-11.

► BSU has compiled an all-time record of 979-485-91 (.659) in 1,555 games.
