## THE GAME

The Bemidji State University football team (0-0; 0-0 NSIC) begins the 2010 regular season with a nonconference bout at Minot State University (0-0; 0-0 Dakota Athletic Conference), in the 12th annual 'Beaver Bash'. The Bemidji State Beavers finished last season 8-3 (7-3 NSIC, 1-3rd), while the Beavers of Minot State went 8-3 (7-1 DAC, 1st) with a trip to the NAIA National Playoffs for the first time since 2002. BSU has opened at MSU four times and owns a 4-0 record in those contests. The game will also serve as the opening to the newly renovated Herb Parker Stadium. The stadium received a multi-million dollar face-lift over the last five months, which included converting the field from grass to field turf and installing a state-of-the-art lighting system.

## THE SERIES

The contest between Bemidji State and Minot State will serve as the 12th annual 'Beaver Bash'. BSU owns a 10-1 record in the series and are riding a seven game winning streak against MSU. Bemidji State is 6-0 on Minot State's home field. BSU has averaged 35.8 points per game against MSU, while holding it to 13.9 points per contest. Bemidji State's 'Gang Green' defense has held Minot State to under 10 points on five occasions, including two shutouts (2000 and 2003). BSU has opened the season with its fellow Beavers six times, posting a 6-0 record. Under head coach **Jeff Tesch**, Bemidji State is 5-9 in opening games with a 5-4 record when opening on the road.

## THE COACHES

**Bemidji State:** Jeff Tesch is in his 15th season roaming the sidelines at Bemidji State. He has posted an overall record of 91-60 (.603), which includes a 68-45 (.604) mark in NSIC tilts and a 10-1 record versus Minot State. In 14 seasons, Tesch has established BSU standards for games coached (151), victories (91), career winning percentage (.603) and conference wins (68). Prior to his tenure at BSU, Tesch, a two-time NSIC Coach of the Year (1999 and 2006), spent 12 years as an assistant at North Dakota, two on the staff of Central Missouri and one season at Montana State.

**Concordia:** Paul Rudolph returns for his fourth season as the Head Coach at Minot State University and 12th as a collegiate head coach. Last season, 2009, the Beavers won a share of the DAC title for the second time in three years and played for the DAC Conference Title for the third straight season. Coach Rudolph lead the Beavers to an appearance in the NAIA National Playoffs, the first since 2002. He is a two-time DAC Coach of the Year recipient. Rudolph was an assistant coach for seven seasons at St. Cloud State and served as the head coach at Upper Iowa University from 1991-99.

## THE PROGRAM

Bemidji State's all-time record is 308-395-24 (.441) dating back to 1926, which includes a 172-245-9 (.414) mark in NSIC play. The Beavers own five conference titles (1947, 50, 57, 59 and 2006) and count the 2006 Mineral Water Bowl as their first post-season appearance. Under the direction of Tesch, BSU has posted winning records in 11 of the last 12 years and have registered eight consecutive winning home campaigns.

## QUICK COUNT

• Bemidji State was ranked No. 5 in the NSIC Preseason Coaches' Poll, No. 22 in the USA Today Division II Preseason Top 25 and received votes in the AFCA Preseason Division II Coaches' Poll.

BSU returns 21 of 24 starters from the 2009 squad, including 10 all-conference players.

• The Beavers finished the 2009 season as the No. 1 team in the NSIC in three categories, time of possession (371:49; 33:48/g), 3rd down conversions (79-158; 50%) and were the least penalized team (50; 450 yards, 40.9/g).

• In the final NCAA rankings, BSU was 7th in rushing defense, allowing just 81.2 yards per game, and 14th in total defense, allowing 276.9 yards per game.

• Senior quarterback **Derek Edholm** closed the final nine games of the 2009 season with at least one touchdown pass. Sophomore running back **Dustin Kroepflin** matched that streak with a score in each of his last nine games.

• Sophomore wide receiver **Cam Abram** finished the 2009 campaign with a touchdown in the final three games of the season.

• Senior **Andrew Schultz** is 83 yards from reaching the 1,000 yard plateau for his career. He also needs 12 receptions to reach the 100 career receptions mark.

• BSU Associate Head Coach **Rich Jahner's** son, Trace, is a redshirt freshman at Minot State.

## THE LINE ON THE LINES

Bemidji State returns its entire offensive line from last season, including all-conference players junior left tackle **Davis Mickelson** and junior center **Cory Immerman**. Last season the line protected an all-conference first team quarterback in **Derek Edholm** and all-conference honorable mention running back **Dustin Kroepflin**. On the defensive front, BSU returns two of its three starters from a year ago, including 2008 *Second-Team All-NSIC* **Rob Wills** and 2009 *First-Team All-NSIC* pick **Jordan Lardinois**.

## SEEING RED ZONE

The Beavers spent the 2009 season scoring 35 of the 39 times (89.7-percent) they entered the redzone, scoring 31 touchdowns. The mark ranked second in the NSIC.

## CAPITALIZING ON OPPORTUNITIES

In 2009 the Beavers turned nine of its 19 take-a-ways into points, which includes an Oct. 17 game in which it turned three interceptions and turnover on downs into four touchdowns.

## BSU IN THE TOP 20

Bemidji State finished 2009 ranked among NCAA Division II's top 20 in four statistical categories. The Beavers were 7th in the country in rushing yardage allowed for game (81.2), 12th in pass efficiency (154.77) and turnover margin (.91) and 14th in total defense allowing 276.9 yards of offense and a hair over 20 points per game.

## KEEPING THE BAR HIGH...

In 2009, the team averaged 33.5 points per game. Only four times in BSU's 83-year history has it scored for a better average over the course of a season. The 2004 team currently holds the BSU single-season scoring mark after putting up 422 points in 11 games for a 38.4 points per game average. With 368 points, BSU piled up more points than it did in 34 complete seasons since 1970.

## SCORING STREAK STRETCHED TO 132

With 35 points in the season finale last season, the Beavers have now scored in 132 consecutive games. The last time BSU was held without a single point was Nov. 8, 1997 when Minnesota Duluth defeated BSU 41-0.

## I'LL TAKE 2 IN THE PICK SIX

The Beavers intercepted 13 passes in 2009 and two were returned the distance for a touchdown. Since 1985, only four BSU teams have turned more interceptions into touchdowns. In 2003, the team picked off 23 passes and returned four for scores, while in 1996, 2005, 2006 three TDs were the result of INTs.

## BALL HOGS

Bemidji State finished last season tops in the NSIC in time of possession, leading the category in nine of its 11 games. In 660 minutes of play, the Beavers had the ball in their possession for 371:59—that leaves just 288:01 for their opponents. On average BSU held the ball for 33:48 per game, which included a ridiculous 44:06 of possession Oct. 10 versus Wayne State (Neb.).

## KEEP 'EM UNDER 100

The Bemidji State defense has been hard on opposing rushing attacks for the past four seasons. Despite allowing 235 yards versus Minnesota Duluth Oct. 24, 2009, the Beavers have managed to keep their opponents to an average of just 81.2 yards per game to rank 7th in all of NCAA Division II. In games that BSU has stymied their opposition to 100 or fewer yards on the ground, the Beavers are 8-1 with their only loss coming Oct. 3 despite holding St. Cloud State to a meager 49 yards rushing. Since 1999 BSU is 39-8 when allowing fewer than 100 rushing yards. UMD's Isaac Odum is the only running back to gain over 100 yards versus BSU since Oct. 18, 2008 (139 in 2009 and 106 in 2010).

## BEAVERS VERSUS RANKED OPPONENTS

In 2009, BSU faced four nationally-ranked opponents marking the first time the Beavers have battled four of the American Football Coaches Association's (AFCA) top 25 teams in the same season. Bemidji State was 2-2 versus ranked opponents in 2009 dropping Winona State Oct. 12, then-ranked 20th and earning a 21-10 victory versus No. 14 Wayne State (Neb.) Oct. 10. The Beavers missed a 4-0 mark versus nationally-ranked by the narrowest of margins. BSU battled No. 10 Minnesota State to overtime Sept. 5 before falling to the Mavericks 37-34 and dropped a one-point game, 35-34, to No. 7 Minnesota Duluth Oct. 24.

## EDHOLM CLIMBS BSU TD PASS LIST

Matching a career-best five touchdown passes Oct. 24, **Derek Edholm** surpassed Ben Morie (1998-99) to claim the No. 4 spot in the Beavers' all-time touchdown passes list. With 42 career TDs, he currently sits four scoring strikes behind Jason Smith (46/2000-03) and nine behind BSU's all-time leader Geoff Martinson (51/1998-2001). His 2009 25 TD passes tied for third on BSU's single-season list. Nathan Sannes (2001-05) sits atop the list with 27 TD passes in 2005.

## WE'RE GOIN' STREAKIN'

**Derek Edholm** capped off the 2009 campaign throwing at least one TD in each of the Beavers' last nine games. Running back **Dustin Kroepelin** also scored a TD in each of the Beavers' last nine games. During that stretch he posted 10 touchdowns, running eight in and catching two more.

## COACHING MILESTONES FOR TESCH

In his 15th season, BSU head coach **Jeff Tesch** has accumulated almost every coaching record at BSU. On Oct. 31, 2009 he accomplished two more feats. He posted his 90th career win. Ironically, it came in his 150th game coached at BSU.

## PICK-HAPPY

In the Beavers' final four games of 2009 they totaled nine interceptions, which include three versus Minnesota-Crookston Oct. 17 and three versus U-Mary Oct. 31.

## AIR ATTACK

For a team that posted 19 of its first 29 touchdowns of 2009 via the run, BSU settled into a pretty potent air attack over its last four weeks and a lot of that is thanks to **Derek Edholm**. In his last four games, he threw for 933 yards and 15 touchdowns on 63-of-101 (62.4-percent) while letting go of just one interception. Oct. 24 he posted a career-high 391 yards through the air to rank fifth on the Beavers' single-game passing yardage list.

It begins in early October with the turning of the fall leaves. Students, proud alumni and families from surrounding communities file into a small, picturesque stadium on the shore of Lake Bemidji with fevered expectations for the battles to come. Through the autumn combat, those watchful souls have been blessed to witness an unprecedented era of success. All-America honorees. School records falling by the wayside with an almost dazzling regularity. A stadium where victories occurred with the frequency of a bigfoot sighting just a few short years ago now hosts men with annual dreams of championship and glory.

It's an era of success and excitement that once might have seemed akin to the Christmas fantasies of youth. But under the masterful guidance of 15th-year head coach **Jeff Tesch**, the Bemidji State football program has undergone a remarkable metamorphosis and gone from annual doormat to title contender.

Tesch has posted a 91-60 record at BSU and led the Beavers to a school-record streak of 10 consecutive winning seasons from 1998-2007. During that historic streak he posted four of the six eight-win seasons for a program now in its 85th season of competition. He is the only coach in Bemidji State history to oversee back-to-back eight-win seasons, and his 2000 and 2006 teams set matching school records of nine wins.

Tesch's success at BSU has been remarkable. Upon being named BSU's 15th field general in May 1996, he inherited a program which had won just 16 games in its previous eight seasons, suffering losing streaks of nine, 11 and 18 games in that time. Today, his 91 wins represent more than 30-percent of the program's all-time victories. He has averaged six wins a season at a program which in 70 years prior to his arrival averaged barely three victories each fall. In fact, Tesch's 91 wins in 14 years surpasses the number of victories garnered by the Bemidji State program in the 31 full seasons prior to his arrival — 88.

Tesch has further cemented his legendary status by becoming Bemidji State's all-time leader in coaching victories. He posted his 53rd win at BSU with a 28-20 victory over Minnesota Crookston on Oct. 16, 2004, moving him past H. "Jolly" Erickson, who won 52 games during a 17-year career at BSU from 1938-54.

Tesch's growing list of achievements at Bemidji State has him amongst the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference's coaching deans as well. A two-time NSIC Coach of the Year now in his 15th season at the Bemidji State helm, Tesch and Winona State's Tom Sawyer who enters his 15th year with the Warriors are the longest tenured coaches in the NSIC.

Before taking over at BSU, Tesch spent 11 years as an assistant for annual NCAA Division II playoff contender North Dakota. There, he assumed assistant head coaching duties in 1995. The Fighting Sioux captured at least a share of the North Central Conference championship three consecutive seasons before Tesch's departure in 1996. In addition to coaching duties, Tesch helped the Sioux achieve a 92 percent graduation rate while serving as academic advisor.

Prior to his UND appointment, Tesch spent one year as an assistant at Montana State, followed by a two-year stint as offensive coordinator at Central Missouri State.

A graduate of Moorhead State (Minn.) University who was a free-agent signee with the Atlanta Falcons, Tesch was inducted into the MSU Hall of Fame in the spring of 1998. In 1977, Tesch was the NCAA Division II receiving champion and still holds Dragon single-game and single-season records for receptions.

In 29 years of coaching, Tesch has produced 12 All-America selections and five NFL draft picks.

Jeff and his wife Susan have two children — daughter Tara and son Vincent.
