## THE GAME

The Bemidji State University football team (1-0; 0-0 NSIC, 0-0 NSIC North) begins the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference season at No. 16 Augustana College (S.D.) Sept. 10 at 1 p.m. The Beavers are coming off an Aug. 25 27-0 nonconference victory against Minot State University. The Vikings (0-1; 0-0 NSIC, 0-0 NSIC South) hosted No. 1 and defending national champion University of Minnesota Duluth Sept. 3 and fell by the score of 20-12. The game marks the 40th annual Shrine Game for Augustana.

## THE SERIES

Last season's contest between the Beavers and Vikings was the first since 1989. Augustana won last year's game 10-0 at Chet Anderson Stadium to improve to 4-1 all-time against BSU. The loss for the Beavers marked the first time in 133 games the game failed to score a point. In five games all-time against the Vikings, BSU has only surpassed 10 points once and that was its lone victory (13-6) Sept. 22, 1962. The Beavers are 0-2 at Augustana, losing 22-6 in 1961 and 50-6 in 1989. More series information can be found on page 5.

## THE COACHES

**Bemidji State:** Jeff Tesch is in his 16th season roaming the sidelines at Bemidji State. He has posted an overall record of 99-64 (.607), which includes a 74-47 (.612) mark in NSIC tilts. In 16 seasons, Tesch has established BSU standards for games coached (163), victories (99), career winning percentage (.607) and conference wins (74). Prior to his tenure at BSU, Tesch, a two-time NSIC Coach of the Year (1999 and 2006), spent 12 years as an assistant at North Dakota, two on the staff of Central Missouri and one season at Montana State.

**Augustana:** Mike Aldrich's debut as Augustana's 21st head coach was one for the books. Aldrich took the reins in 2010 and guided the Vikings to a school-record 11 wins. Augustana ended a 21-year drought in NCAA Division II playoff appearances and in the second round defeated four-time national champion Grand Valley State 38-6 at Kirkeby-Over Stadium. It was the first time Augustana hosted a playoff game in addition to earning its first playoff win. Prior to being appointed head coach, Aldrich spent four seasons as the Vikings' defensive coordinator after serving as assistant defensive coordinator and special teams coordinator the previous two seasons.

## THE PROGRAM

Bemidji State's all-time record is 316-398-24 (.444) dating back to 1926, which includes a 177-249-9 (.416) mark in NSIC play. The Beavers own five conference titles (1947, 50, 57, 59 and 2006) and count the 2006 Mineral Water Bowl as their first post-season appearance. Under the direction of Tesch, BSU has posted winning records in 11 of the last 12 years and have registered nine consecutive winning home campaigns.

## QUICK COUNT

- Head coach **Jeff Tesch** is just one win short of 100 for his career.
- The Beavers were slated eighth in the NSIC Preseason Coaches' Poll.
- Senior **Cory Immerman** (OL) and junior **Brian Leonhardt** (TE) were named to the *Consensus Draft Services 2011 Preseason All-America Honorable Mention Football Team*.
- BSU returned nine all-conference players to the 2011 roster, including first-teamer Leonhardt.
- The Beavers were 5-1 in 2010 when junior **Dustin Kroepin** rushed for a touchdown and are 13-1 in his two-year career.
- BSU has never played on Augustana's current field, Kirkeby-Over Stadium. That facility opened in 2009 and the Vikings have lost just twice at home in that time.
- The Beavers held Minot State to just 27 rushing yards Aug. 25. Augustana struggled on the ground against Minnesota Duluth Sept. 3, netting just nine rushing yards.

## THE LINE ON THE LINES

Bemidji State returns most of its entire offensive line from last season, including all-conference players senior left tackle **Davis Mickelson**, senior center **Cory Immerman** and junior left guard **Brett DeLange**. Last season the line protected an all-conference second team running back in **Dustin Kroepin** and honorable mention quarterback Derek Edholm. On the defensive front, BSU will look to defensive ends senior **Josh Beste** and junior **Bryan Syrstad** and nose tackle sophomore **Matt Shaver** to replace three all-conference linemen.

## HOME COOKIN'

At home, the Beavers have a streak of nine winning seasons, owning a 4-1 home record in 2010. Since **Jeff Tesch** took the helm of the BSU football program prior to the 1996 season, the Beavers have posted a 53-21 overall record with a 42-15 mark in NSIC play at "The Chet." Tesch and the Beavers own undefeated home slates in 1998 (4-0), 2000 (5-0) and 2005 (4-0).

## SEEING RED ZONE

The Beavers have posted an 89.7 percent mark in the red zone the past two seasons. In 2010, the Beavers were 35-of-39, scoring 221 points (29 TDs and six FGs) to rank second in the NSIC. BSU is 4-of-5 (80%) this season.

## TAKE IT TO THE HOUSE, TAKE TO THE HOUSE

In 2010, the Gang Green defense returned four interceptions or fumbles for touchdowns. The trend continued in week one of the 2011 season, as freshman **Scott Christensen** took an interception to the end zone for a 27-yard return - playing in his first collegiate game.

## KEEP 'EM UNDER 100

The Bemidji State defense has been hard on opposing rushing attacks for the past four seasons. Despite allowing 235 yards versus Minnesota Duluth Oct. 24, 2009, the Beavers managed to keep their opponents to an average of just 81.2 yards per game to rank 7th in all of NCAA Division II in 2009.

The Beavers started the 2010 campaign on the right foot, knocking the Minot State running game backwards -10 yards and then holding Augustana to 63 yards rushing, following that performance with a stingy 31 rushing yards allowed against Southwest Minnesota State. BSU had a uncharacteristic three games Sept. 25-Oct. 9, allowing 235 yards to Minnesota Duluth (Sept. 25), 139 to Upper Iowa (Oct. 2) and 227 to Concordia University (Oct. 9). The Beavers got back on track

against MSU Moorhead (Oct. 16), allowing just 71 yards rushing. U-Mary posted 105 yards on the ground against BSU Oct. 23 and Northern State posted 110 Oct. 30. The Huskies ran on BSU Nov. 6, totaling 241 on the ground, allowing Damon Treat 125 of those yards. UMC rushed for 117 yards in the season finale. The team finished the 2010 season 39th in the nation in rushing yards allowed.

BSU allowed just 27 yards on the ground in the 2011 season opener against Minot State. The team is 1-0 this season when allowing less than 100 yards rushing and since 1999 are 43-8.

## AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL

Known for its run defense the 'Gang Green' was better defending the pass in 2010, allowing just 147.0 yards per game through the air, ranking them third in the conference and 15th in the nation. In 11 games, BSU opponents completed just 147 passes in 286 attempts (51.4%) with eight interceptions.

The 2011 secondary and linebacking core got right after it against Minot State (Aug. 25), picking the Beaver quarterback five times. The mark was the most since taking five away from Upper Iowa Nov. 9, 2007. Senior safety **Brody Scheff** brought down a career-high two interceptions that totaled 40 yards.

## BEAVERS VERSUS RANKED OPPONENTS

In 2009, BSU faced four nationally-ranked opponents marking the first time the Beavers have battled four of the American Football Coaches Association's (AFCA) top 25 teams in the same season.

Bemidji State was 2-2 versus ranked opponents in 2009 dropping Winona State Oct. 12, then-ranked 20th and earning a 21-10 victory versus No. 14 Wayne State (Neb.) Oct. 10. The Beavers missed a 4-0 mark versus nationally-ranked by the narrowest of margins. BSU battled No. 10 Minnesota State to overtime Sept. 5 before falling to the Mavericks 37-34 and dropped a one-point game, 35-34, to No. 7 Minnesota Duluth Oct. 24. In 2010, BSU fell to the Bulldogs, who were ranked No. 2 in the AFCA poll, 44-21. Augustana found its way in the top 25 in the AFCA and DII Football polls after defeating Bemidji State 10-0 Sept. 11. St. Cloud State was ranked 25th in the 35-14 loss to the Huskies Nov. 6.

There are three opponents on the 2011 schedule currently ranked in the AFCA poll, which starts with Augustana Sept. 10.

## SCORING STREAK SNAPPED AT 133

With a 24-6 victory at Minot State to start the 2010 season, the Beavers had scored in 133 consecutive games. In a 10-0 loss to Augustana College at Chet Anderson Stadium Sept. 11, 2010 the streak ended. The last time BSU was held without a single point was Nov. 8, 1997 when Minnesota Duluth defeated BSU 41-0.

## COACHING MILESTONES FOR TESCH

In his 16th season, BSU head coach **Jeff Tesch** has accumulated almost every coaching record at BSU. On Oct. 31, 2009 he accomplished two more feats. He posted his 90th career win. Ironically, it came in his 150th game coached at BSU. He is just one victory short of reaching the 100th win plateau. He currently ranks among the top 25 Division II coaches in all-time wins and winning percentage.

## WE'RE GOIN' STREAKIN'

Running back **Dustin Kroepelin** scored a TD in each of the Beavers' last nine games in 2009. During that stretch he posted 10 touchdowns, running eight in and catching two more. He did not play against Minot State (Aug. 28, 2010) and ended the streak in the loss to Augie (Sept. 11, 2010). He finished the last seven games of 2010, finding the end zone in six games, scoring eight times, seven on the ground and one in the air. In his career, when he finds the end zone - through the air or on the ground - the Beavers hold a 14-2 record.

## BLANKED

A record 4,711 fans packed Chet Anderson Stadium Aug. 25 to see Bemidji State roll past its fellow Beavers in Minot State University 27-0 and record its first shutout since Nov. 6, 2004 when BSU downed Wayne State College 24-0 at the H.H.H. Metrodome in Minneapolis, Minn. The last time the Beavers blanked an opponent at The Chet was Oct. 19, 2002 with a 37-0 victory against Southwest Minnesota State University.

It begins in early October with the turning of the fall leaves. Students, proud alumni and families from surrounding communities file into a small, picturesque stadium on the shore of Lake Bemidji with fevered expectations for the battles to come. Through the autumn combat, those watchful souls have been blessed to witness an unprecedented era of success. All-America honorees. School records falling by the wayside with an almost dazzling regularity. A stadium where victories occurred with the frequency of a bigfoot sighting just a few short years ago now hosts men with annual dreams of championship and glory.

It's an era of success and excitement that once might have seemed akin to the Christmas fantasies of youth. But under the masterful guidance of 16th-year head coach **Jeff Tesch**, the Bemidji State football program has undergone a remarkable metamorphosis and gone from annual doormat to title contender.

Tesch has posted a 99-64 record at BSU and led the Beavers to a school-record streak of 10 consecutive winning seasons from 1998-2007. During that historic streak he posted four of the six eight-win seasons for a program now in its 86th season of competition. He is the only coach in Bemidji State history to oversee back-to-back eight-win seasons, and his 2000 and 2006 teams set matching school records of nine wins.

Tesch's success at BSU has been remarkable. Upon being named BSU's 15th field general in May 1996, he inherited a program which had won just 16 games in its previous eight seasons, suffering losing streaks of nine, 11 and 18 games in that time. Today, his 99 wins represent more than 30-percent of the program's all-time victories. He has averaged six wins a season at a program which in 70 years prior to his arrival averaged barely three victories each fall. In fact, Tesch's 99 wins in 16 years surpasses the number of victories garnered by the Bemidji State program in the 31 full seasons prior to his arrival — 88.

Tesch has further cemented his legendary status by becoming Bemidji State's all-time leader in coaching victories. He posted his 53rd win at BSU with a 28-20 victory over Minnesota Crookston on Oct. 16, 2004, moving him past H. "Jolly" Erickson, who won 52 games during a 17-year career at BSU from 1938-54.

Tesch's growing list of achievements at Bemidji State has him amongst the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference's coaching deans as well. A two-time NSIC Coach of the Year now in his 16th season at the Bemidji State helm, Tesch and Winona State's Tom Sawyer who enters his 16th year with the Warriors are the longest tenured coaches in the NSIC.

Before taking over at BSU, Tesch spent 11 years as an assistant for annual NCAA Division II playoff contender North Dakota. There, he assumed assistant head coaching duties in 1995. The Fighting Sioux captured at least a share of the North Central Conference championship three consecutive seasons before Tesch's departure in 1996. In addition to coaching duties, Tesch helped the Sioux achieve a 92 percent graduation rate while serving as academic advisor.

Prior to his UND appointment, Tesch spent one year as an assistant at Montana State, followed by a two-year stint as offensive coordinator at Central Missouri State.

A graduate of Moorhead State (Minn.) University who was a free-agent signee with the Atlanta Falcons, Tesch was inducted into the MSU Hall of Fame in the spring of 1998. In 1977, Tesch was the NCAA Division II receiving champion and still holds Dragon single-game and single-season records for receptions.

In 30 years of coaching, Tesch has produced 12 All-America selections and five NFL draft picks.

Jeff and his wife Susan have two children — daughter Tara and son Vincent.
