## THE GAME

The Bemidji State University women's basketball team (5-9; 3-6 NSIC) begins a four-game Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference homestand Jan. 13-14 when St. Cloud State University and Concordia University, St. Paul visit BSU Gymnasium. The contest with the Huskies will begin at 6 p.m. Friday and the tip with the Golden Bears is scheduled for 4 p.m. Saturday.

## THE BEAVERS

The Beavers' 3-6 NSIC record stands in a three-way tie for 10th with this weekend's opponents. The Beavers have struggled since opening the NSIC season on the road with a 3-1 record, falling in six straight games (five straight NSIC games), most recently at Augustana College (91-69) and No. 8 Wayne State College (74-49). BSU is 2-3 at home this season (0-3 in NSIC games). The Beavers have a 78.3 percentage from the charity stripe, which ranks second in the conference and seventh in the nation. BSU has the third best 3-point percentage in the NSIC this season, shooting at a 34.2 clip. The Beavers have three players scoring in double-figures, led by sophomore **Morgan Lee's** 12.4 points per contest.

# Game Notes

## Fast Break:

- The Beavers are stuck on 499 program wins, looking for 500 this weekend.
- Sophomore **Kate Warmack's** 50.4 percent from the field ranks fifth in the NSIC.
- BSU is second in the league in NSIC games only with a 78.9 percentage from the charity stripe. Its 78.3 percentage overall ranks second in the league and seventh in the nation. The Beavers have four players in the top 15 in the league in free throw percentage, led by sophomore **Ellie Wessling's** 87.5 percent from the line which ranks third in the league.
- In league games only, the Beavers are touting three players in the top 20 for scoring. Sophomore **Morgan Lee** (12.8 ppg - 13th), junior **Shannon Thompson** (11.8 ppg - 16th) and Warmack (11.4 ppg - 20th).
- Lee has made 19 3-pointers in league games this season to rank second in the category and average 2.11 3-pointers made per game.
- The Beavers are averaging 65.7 points per NSIC game this season to rank sixth, but are allowing 72.8 points per contest to rank tied for last.
- BSU is 4-1 when it has a lead or is tied at halftime.

**Last Time Out:** The Beavers lost both games in the first half last weekend trailing by 22 against Augustana and 15 against Wayne State at the break. BSU was unable to recover in the second, but tied the second frame with the Vikings and falling by 10 to the Wildcats. Junior **Shannon Thompson** averaged 13.0 points and 5.0 rebounds per game on the NSIC road weekend. In the two games she shot 9-for-16 (56.3%) from the field, 6-for-10 (60%) from beyond the arc, added five assists and five steals in 31.5 minutes per game.

**The Huskies:** The Huskies hold a 6-7 overall and 3-6 NSIC record. SCSU is 1-3 in its last four games after splitting a conference road weekend Jan. 7-8, downing Upper Iowa 73-70 before falling at Winona State 58-40. The Huskies are tied for 13th in scoring offense in league games this season with 59.1 points per game. On the defensive end, SCSU has a NSIC-best 12.7 steals per game. Sophomore Sam Price has 8.9 points per game to lead the Huskies. Lori Fish, head coach for SCSU, is in her fourth season with the Huskies.

**All-time Series vs the Huskies:** The Beavers and Huskies have been doing battle since 1969 with SCSU holding the all-time advantage 30-14. BSU is 1-4 in the last five games and 2-16 in the last 18 meetings, dating back to 1997. The Beavers last defeated the Huskies Feb. 6, 2010, 70-63 at BSU Gymnasium. Last season BSU fell in the only contest between the teams 70-51 in St. Cloud.

**The Golden Bears:** The Golden Bears are 6-9 overall and 3-6 in conference play. CU is on a six-game losing streak, most recently falling at Winona State 64-51 and at Upper Iowa 62-44. The Golden Bears are scoring 64.3 points and allowing 64.5 points per game this season. Concordia-St. Paul is 1-5 on the road this season and 1-3 in NSIC road contests. Freshman Anika Whiting is leading CU with 10.7 points and 6.7 rebounds per game. Paul Fessler is in his 12th season as head coach at Concordia-St. Paul.

**All-time Series vs the Golden Bears:** The Beavers are 11-24 all-time against the Golden Bears and are 0-5 in the last five and 1-9 in the last 10. The Beavers last downed CU 82-74 Dec. 8, 2006 in Bemidji. In the only meeting last season BSU lost 85-70 in St. Paul.

**NSIC Preseason Poll:** The Bemidji State women's basketball team was pegged to finish 13th in the 2011-12 Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference Preseason Coaches' Poll, released by the league office Oct. 25. The Beavers closed last season winning two of the last four games en route to a 4-18 conference and 7-19 overall record to sit 13th in the final league standings. Junior forward **Jessie Althoff** (Becker, Minn) was named BSU's player to watch.

**BSU's Player to Watch - Jessie Althoff:** Will miss at least first half of 2011-12 season due to injury...Appeared in 20 games as a sophomore, which included 19 starts... Ranked second on the team in scoring (9.1 pts/gm) and third in rebounding (3.9 reb/gm)... Was one of six BSU players to shoot higher than 80 percent from the charity stripe (80.6 percent) on a team that finished ranked in the top 25 nationally for free throw percentage... Led the Beavers in scoring five times... Tallied double-figures in scoring in 11 games... Paced BSU to victory with team-leading 13 points and a career-high nine boards against Grand View Nov. 20... Led the Beavers in scoring with 12 points in an 83-31 dominating victory against St. Scholastica... Tallied season-high 16 points versus Northern State Jan. 29... Missed final six games of the season due to an injury suffered against Minnesota Duluth Feb. 5.

**Nearing 500:** The women's basketball program at Bemidji State began in 1967 and since its amassed 499 victories as a program. The program currently has a 499-575-1 (.465) all-time record.

**Century Mark:** The Beavers defeated Mayville State University 100-51 Nov. 19 to record their first 100-point game since Nov. 20, 2009 vs Martin Luther (108-63). BSU has posted 100 or more points on 14 occasions in its 45 year history. The first time the Beavers reached 100 points was ironically against Mayville State during the 1977-78 season as BSU won 104-42. The complete list of 100 points games in BSU history can be found on page eight of the game notes.

**Better Get an Umbrella, It's Raining 3's:** The Beavers knocked down a program record 14 3-pointers in the 100-51 victory against Mayville State Nov. 19. The mark broke the previous record of 13 set against North Dakota State. Senior **Samantha Baldwin** found the bottom of the net from beyond the arc a career-high six times to pace the Beavers. Five different players contributed the rest of the eight threes in the game. BSU has posted five or more 3-pointers 11 times this season and is 5-6 when doing so.

**The Difference a Year Makes:** Sophomore **Kate Warmack** only recorded more than 10 points twice during her freshman campaign. In the first two games of the season she posted 18 and 26 points, respectfully. Through 14 games she has 12.1 points per game. She has also been dominate on the boards, grabbing 10 against Mayville State (Nov. 19), tying a career-high with 11 against Palm Beach Atlantic (Nov. 26) before posting a career-best 12 at Winona State (Dec. 9). She leads the team in that category with 6.5 per contest. She had 26 points and 10 rebounds against Mayville State to record her first-career double-double and 13 points and 12 rebounds at WSU for the second double-double. She is also shooting 50.4 percent from the field to rank fifth in the NSIC.

**FREE Throws:** Last season the team finished 21st nationally in free throw percentage (75.7%). This season, BSU is second in the NSIC and seventh in the nation in the category with an 78.3 percent clip. Sophomore **Ellie Wessling** leads BSU with an 87.5 percentage.

**Building Blocks:** The Beavers are sixth in the NSIC in blocked shots per game with 3.36 per contest (47 total). Sophomore **Kate Warmack** has 18 rejections (T-9th, 1.42 bpg), while sophomore **Emily Kaus** has 16 blocks (12th, 1.14 bpg).

Mike Curfman is in his seventh year as head women's basketball coach for the Beavers. Curfman has directed Bemidji State University to a 64-104 overall record (.381) in his six seasons while posting a 35-77 (.313) mark in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference. Curfman is the third-longest tenured coach in the program's history, trailing only Doreen Zierer who coached 11 seasons (1990-2002) and Ruth Howe who coached the programs' first 10 seasons (1967-77). Curfman is fourth on BSU's all-time coaching victories list. He trails Zierer (129), Howe (95) and Joan Campbell (70).

After posting his lowest win total at BSU in 2008-09, Curfman and the BSU women's basketball team bounced back with a 12-15 overall mark in 2009-10, making it the fourth season out of five that the Beavers have tallied more than 10 wins. The last time BSU had as many 10 win-seasons in such a short period of time was from 1994-99, when Zierer led the Beavers to four 10-win seasons in five years.

Rejuvenating a program is nothing new to Curfman, he came to Bemidji State after six years at the helm of the University of Minnesota, Crookston program where three times during his tenure his teams set or equaled school records for wins (2000-01, 2001-02 and 2004-05) and racked up 55 victories during his final four seasons.

While at UMC, he helped to elevate the program to the NCAA Division II level. After a 1-26 season in 1999-2000, Curfman directed the Golden Eagles to a school-record nine wins in 2000-01 and increased UMC's win total to 16 the following year. In 2002-03, under Curfman, UMC made the NSIC tournament for the first time, cruising to the championship game before falling to NCAA Tournament bound University of Minnesota Duluth. In his last season at UMC in 2004-05 his Golden Eagles tied for fourth place in the NSIC posting a league record of 8-6 while going 16-12 overall and making their first ever appearance in the North Central Regional Polls. Curfman has mentored 10 All-Conference selections as a head coach including 2000-01 NSIC Newcomer of the Year and 2001-02 Player of the Year Jessica Forsline and was himself named as the 2002 NSIC Coach of the Year.

Curfman's teams have done equally as well in the classroom. During his tenure at UMC, the Golden Eagles posted at least a 3.0 team grade point average and finished in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's Top 10 Academic National Rankings with a team G.P.A. of better than 3.4 in 2004-05.

Previous to taking over the UMC program, Curfman was an assistant coach at St. Cloud State University (1994-99), serving as Dr. Lori Ulferts' top assistant for five seasons. He also coached under Dr. Ulferts at Moorhead State University (1992-94) as an assistant while serving as the head coach of the junior varsity team. He has presented at a number of camps and clinics and is a member of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) and the Minnesota State High School League Coaches Association.

A native of Fosston, Minn., Curfman was an Academic All-America selection for the UMC basketball team while earning his A.A.S. degree. He then moved on to Concordia College in Moorhead, Minn. where he graduated in 1992 with his B.A. in Business Administration while captaining the Cobber men's basketball program. In 1994, Curfman earned his MBA in business administration from Moorhead State University (now Minnesota State University Moorhead) while acting as an assistant coach for the Dragons' women's basketball program.

Curfman currently resides in Fosston with his wife Michelle, his son Caleb and his daughter Emily.
