## THE GAME

The Bemidji State University women's basketball team opens the lid on the 2011-12 season Nov. 3 at BSU Gymnasium with a 7:30 tip with a contest against Lakehead University (Ontario). The game marks the earliest the Beavers have ever started the regular season in the 42-year history of the program. BSU finished last season winning two of its last four games to close the campaign with a 7-19 overall and 4-18 Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference record to finish 13th in the final standings.

## THE BEAVERS

BSU was tabbed 13th in the 2011-12 NSIC Preseason Coaches' Poll Oct. 25. The Beavers return 10 student-athletes from last season's roster and welcome six newcomers. The lone seniors on the team are **Samantha Baldwin** (G, 5-7, St. Thomas, N.D.) and **Taylor Davis** (F, 5-10, Crookston, Minn.). Twelve of the 16 student-athletes on the roster are listed as freshmen or sophomores, as the team added six newcomers (five freshmen, one sophomore transfer) to the roster during the off-season.

The Beavers got their first taste of competition Oct. 27 with an exhibition game at Jamestown College (N.D.). BSU got off to a slow start in the game, failing to score in the first six minutes of play. At halftime the scoreboard read 44-19 in favor of the Jimmies. BSU came back and won the second half 49-37, but the deficit was too large to overcome and the Beavers fell 81-68. Sophomore **Kate Warmack** (C, East Grand Forks, N.D.) led BSU with 14 points on 5-of-6 shooting from the field. Freshman **Jessi Corrick** (G, Grand Rapids, Minn.) posted the only other double-digit point night for BSU with 11 points.

## THE THUNDERWOLVES

The Thunderwolves are 3-9 in their exhibition season entering the contest with Bemidji State today. Lakehead is 1-9 in its last 10 games after starting the season 2-0 in late September. Most recently the Thunderwolves were out on the west coast of Canada where it went 0-3 against University of Victoria (70-56), University of Vancouver (107-71) and University of Fraser Valley. Senior guard Carolyn Fragale led the team in the three games averaging 15.7 points per game. Lakehead closes its nonconference exhibition schedule with BSU and two games at Minot State University (Nov. 4-5) before opening Ontario University Athletics play Nov. 11 at Queens University (Kingston, Ontario). The Thunderwolves are coached by Jon Kreiner, who is in his ninth season at LU.

## THE SERIES

Bemidji State and Lakehead have met once all-time with the Thunderwolves winning 79-63 in 1984.

**Mike Curfman** is in his seventh year as head women's basketball coach for the Beavers. Curfman has directed Bemidji State University to a 62-102 overall record (.378) in his six seasons while posting a 35-77 (.313) mark in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference. Curfman is the third-longest tenured coach in the program's history, trailing only Doreen Zierer who coached 11 seasons (1990-2002) and Ruth Howe who coached the programs' first 10 seasons (1967-77). Curfman is fourth on BSU's all-time coaching victories list. He trails Zierer (129), Howe (95) and Joan Campbell (70).

After posting his lowest win total at BSU in 2008-09, Curfman and the BSU women's basketball team bounced back with a 12-15 overall mark in 2009-10, making it the fourth season out of five that the Beavers have tallied more than 10 wins. The last time BSU had as many 10 win-seasons in such a short period of time was from 1994-99, when Zierer led the Beavers to four 10-win seasons in five years.

Curfman currently resides in Fosston with his wife Michelle, his son Caleb and his daughter Emily.
