STUDENT HOSTS SERVE A CRITICAL FUNCTION TO BEMIDJI STATE UNIVERSITY ATHLETICS. THIS FUNCTION CARRIES WITH IT IMPORTANT RESPONSIBILITIES. APPROPRIATE CONDUCT IS REQUIRED OF YOU BY INSTITUTIONAL AND NCAA STANDARDS. PLEASE ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS.

1. It is against the University's Student Code of Conduct for any student to use, possess or be under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs while on University premises or while involved in University activities. This pertains to the duration of your hosting responsibilities.
2. Do not provide the prospect with material gifts (e.g. souvenirs or clothing items). It is against NCAA rules to purchase such items with the entertainment money provided to you upon signing this form.
3. Do not transport the prospect more than 30 miles from campus.
4. Do not allow in-person conversations between the prospect and a booster of Bemidji State University (if an unplanned meeting occurs, an exchange of greetings is permissible, but in a polite manner do not allow the contact to go beyond a greeting.)
5. You may not use an automobile for the prospect or yourself that has been provided by Bemidji State University, your coaching staff or a booster.
6. Conduct yourself in a manner that represents yourself, your team and your University in a positive way.
7. You may receive a maximum of \$30 per day for a prospect. The \$30 is intended to cover the actual costs of entertainment (other than meals) for the prospect and his/her parents. If you are a host to more than one prospect, you may receive \$15 per day for each prospect after the first.
8. Abide by all other University and State regulations.
